## Guest Artist - Bobby Shew



Bobby Shew has served as jazz trumpet soloist in the famed NORAD multi-service band and in the Tommy Dorsey Orchestra under the direction of Sam Donahue. After his stint with Tommy Dorsey, Bobby played with Woody Herman's band and played for Della Reese and Buddy Rich. Bobby has played with Big Bands and Pop Star groups in Las Vegas and Los Angeles. He was active with Art Pepper, Bud Shank, Horace Silver Quintet, and many others.

Today, in addition to a busy performing and private teaching schedule, Bobby is actively involved in educational programs, conducting clinics and master classes at high schools and college campuses all over the world. He has been active on the Board of Directors of the International Trumpet Guild, and has acted as National Trumpet Chairman for the International Association of Jazz Educators for 16 years. He authors numerous articles of educational interest in various trade magazines, all translated into several languages for worldwide distribution.

Today, Bobby continues to tour internationally and to produce and record excellent music and participate in educational programs. Bobby has endorsed Yamaha equipment for years. He appears at the Rocky Mountain Trumpet Fest thanks to an educational grant from Yamaha.



## The Rocky Mountain Trumpet Fest Story

The 2010 Rocky Mountain Trumpet Fest will be the sixth time the Trumpet Fest has met. The event started with a small group of trumpet players who met in Monument, Colorado to try a few horns and play some music. Following that first meeting, three of the group, Janet Myers, Bill Spickler and Dave Stephens incorporated the Trumpet Fest and expanded the event significantly. The following year the event was held at the University of Denver hosted by Al Hood. It then moved to CU-Boulder hosted by Terry Sawchuk followed by University of Northern Colorado hosted by Rob Murray followed by Colorado State University in Fort Collins hosted by Dan Kuehn. The 2010 event is at Metropolitan State College of Denver and will be hosted by Michael Hengst, Asst. Prof of Trumpet with the support of David Kish, Director of Bands.



Currently there are three members of the Rocky Mountain Trumpet Fest Board of Directors, Ritchie Clendenin, Bill Spickler and David Stephens. But the Board wishes to acknowledge the many volunteers and musicians who have made the event a great success. We would not be able to conduct the Trumpet Fest without the tremendous support of the many faculty members from around the Rocky Mountain region. In addition we have received wonderful support from the many guest artists and exhibitors who have helped each year. ## Guest Artist - Brian Shaw



Brian Shaw is Assistant Professor of Trumpet and Jazz Studies at Louisiana State University and is Co-Principal Trumpet of the Dallas Wind Symphony.

Brian has recently recorded a CD on Baroque trumpet titled *Virtuoso Concertos for Clarino* including works by Michael Haydn, F.X. Richter, and others. He has also performed on Baroque trumpet throughout North America.

Interested in old and new music alike, Shaw has been the dedicatee of several works for the modern trumpet, most notably Joseph Turrin's *Two Images*

(2005). In addition, he is the dedicatee of composer Brett Dietz's *redshift*, a new trumpet concerto that was premiered with the Eastman Wind Ensemble in May of 2010. He can also be heard as principal trumpet on the premiere recording of John Corigliano's Symphony no. 3 (*Circus Maximus*) with the University of Texas Wind Ensemble, and on the Dallas Wind Symphony's Grammy-Nominated CD, *Garden of Dreams*.

As a jazz trumpeter, he is a recent addition to the popular LSU concert series "Hot Summer Nights and Cool Jazz" playing alongside his colleagues pianist Willis Delony and bassist Bill Grimes. Shaw can be heard on lead trumpet on the 2009 Allora Records release of *Facing the Mirror* - the debut album of the Dave Rivello Ensemble.

He maintains an active schedule on modern and baroque trumpet as a freelance player in the classical and jazz idioms, and has written works for solo trumpet, trumpet ensemble, solo voice, wind ensemble, jazz ensemble, and orchestra. He placed first in the International Trumpet Guild's 2002 Solo Competition as well as many other competitions

Brian holds degrees from Eastern Illinois University (B.Mus), the Eastman School (M.Mus) and the University of Texas at Austin (D.M.A.). While at ESM, he was Principal Trumpet of the Eastman Wind Ensemble during the group's 2004 Far East Tour and the 2005 Carnegie Hall concert.
